BENEFITS TO HORSEPOWER

Endowments provide a consistent and permanent funding that will support HORSEPOWER's programs for generations to come. An endowed gift is made with the intention to preserve the principal value in perpetuity. Because of their performance, endowments are among the most advantageous sources of funding for non-profits. HORSEPOWER is subject to the volatility of the economy, including its effect on donated revenues and fixed costs. Endowments help ensure sustainability even when other funding sources become less reliable. As a source of consistent funding, our endowment will help provide clients, volunteers, staff and donors with an assurance of the stability of our programs.







BENEFITS TO YOU

When establishing an endowment with the HORSEPOWER Foundation, you will feel satisfaction in knowing that you have made a long-term investment in strengthening your community, helping individuals with challenges – including children with special needs, at-risk youth and veterans. Depending on your level of investment, you will have the power to choose how your investment will help HORSEPOWER. Through your endowment, you may also build a stronger connection with the staff and program recipients that benefit from your generosity. Endowments are an excellent way to honor someone special or to memorialize a loved one. Colleagues, friends, and family may choose to support the endowed fund you created because they know how special it is to you. Your family will enjoy a long relationship with HORSEPOWER built around support for something you care deeply about.







HOW DOES THE ENDOWMENT WORK?

Endowment funds are prudently invested by the HORSE-**POWER** Foundation. The portfolio is diversified to provide healthy long-term returns that should outperform the general market over time while minimizing losses during market downturns. Each year, a percentage of your endowed fund's value (striving for a 36-month rolling average) will be distributed to HORSE**POWER** as designated by the donor.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Establishing an endowed fund with the HORSE**POWER** Foundation is easy. A development professional will guide you through the process and discuss options that fit your situation and your wishes. Generally, the procedure for endowing a fund is as follows:

- The use and purpose of the endowed gift is documented in a written Endowment Fund Agreement (EFA) between the donor and the HORSE**POWER** Foundation. Once established, your endowment fund will be used exclusively for the purpose outlined in the EFA.
- Your endowment may be funded with cash, stocks, estate planning and more.
- If you wish, with a minimum gift of \$25,000, you can establish a named endowment at the HORSE**POWER** Foundation directed to a specific purpose. Options are available to allow you to reach the \$25,000 minimum over time.
